Brazoria County Master Gardeners will offer some 1,800 plants: 500 Blackberry & Strawberry, and 1,300 plants including apples, avocados, figs, peaches, pears, plums, persimmons, pomegranates, and hybrid mulberry will be offered.

Citrus (both standard and dwarf) will include all four major groups of limes, lemons, oranges and grapefruits. Tangerines, satsumas and other mandarins will be available.

New specialty plants such as blueberries, olives, and a southern variety of nectarine will be offered.

Organic fertilizer will be available for purchase in 8 lbs. and 40 lbs. bags.

A list of all plants offered will be passed out before the sale starts at 8:00 a.m. Make sure you keep your sales receipts when you load your plants.
