Safety Seat Inspections

Child safety seat checkups routinely discover that four out of five children are not properly restrained in appropriate child safety seats or safety belt systems. Numerous compatibility problems between child safety seats and motor vehicles exist. Saving lives and reducing injuries to children in motor vehicle crashes is the primary goal of child passenger safety technicians. Learn the best way to install your child safety seat in your vehicle for your child. Rollover Convincer

Excuses for not wearing safety belts, dangers of unrestrained occupants, hazards of pick up trucks and rollovers, proper safety belt fit and booster seats are among the items presented during a the passenger safety demonstration. All these points are reinforced with a demonstration with the Rollover Convincer. The Rollover Convincer is basically the cab from a pickup truck attached to a frame with a motor and mounted on top of a trailer. When demonstrating the Rollover Convincer, an adult dummy is used in the driver position, and either another adult dummy or a child size dummy in a safety seat is used in the passenger position. First, the demonstration shows what happens when the dummies are correctly using their safety belts. Then, the dummies are unbuckled and the demonstration is repeated. Children part with a bag of passenger safety brochures, stickers, and puzzle pages. Excellent for schools and community events.
